Capital Project Referendum December 12, 2017 Defeated 545-462

- \$44,261,000
 - * ~ \$30 million +/- for Elementary Addition
 - * ~ \$14 million +/- @ MS/HS, Bus Garage, and Biomass
- Tax Impact over 20 years (\$75,000 home)
 - *\$169.71/year or \$3.26/week







Project Costs and Tax Impact \$38,889,800

- \$38,889,800
 - * ~ \$28 million +/- for Elementary Addition
 - * ~ \$10 million +/- @ MS/HS, Bus Garage, and Biomass
- Tax Impact over 20 years (\$75,000 home)
 - *\$120/year or \$2.31/week
 - *Expected to begin with the September 2021 tax bill
- Tax Impact Estimates <u>WITH</u> anticipated savings:
 *\$70/year or \$1.35/week



PROPOSITION #1

Shall the Board of Education undertake a project consisting of (i) renovations and improvements to the Middle School/High School, Bus Garage and Blomass Building (II) the construction of an approximately 71,300 sq. ft. elementary school addition to the Middle School/High School and (iii) the acquistion of up to 51 acres of land adjacent to the school campus and the construction thereon of new althelic fields, parking and access roads, a concessions building with tolet facilities and an on-site sewage disposal system, including, for all of the folgoing, related site improvements, original furnishings, fixtures and equipment, architectural fees, and all other costs incidental to such work at a total estimated cost not to exceed \$38,889,800 and obtain the necessary funds by using ■ \$2,000,000 from the District's Capital Reserve Fund, any available state aid and the levy of a lax upon the taxable properly of the School District to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board of Education shall determine and in anticipation of such tax bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$36,889,800, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due.








