Proposed Turin Ridge Riders Trail Notes of Interest

- It is our intent to maintain >600 feet separation from the educational buildings using proposed route 1 (yellow highlight). The majority of the trail is below grade of the school and measures will be taken wherever possible to run behind brush or other natural barriers to keep the snowmobile traffic out of sight.
- The route will be flagged/fenced as appropriate to confine traffic to the trail
- The speed limit will be posted using School Zone signs at 20 MPH. The Tug Hill Snowmobile Map will include a blow up indicating the 20 MPH speed limit and School Zone designation.
- TRR has spoken with the Lewis County Sheriff's Department about the importance of the trail. The Sheriff's department acknowledged that they would support our efforts to maintain a safe trail as required.
- Traffic levels are anticipated to be at their lowest levels while school is in session. The highest traffic levels are anticipated on weekends, evenings, and holidays.

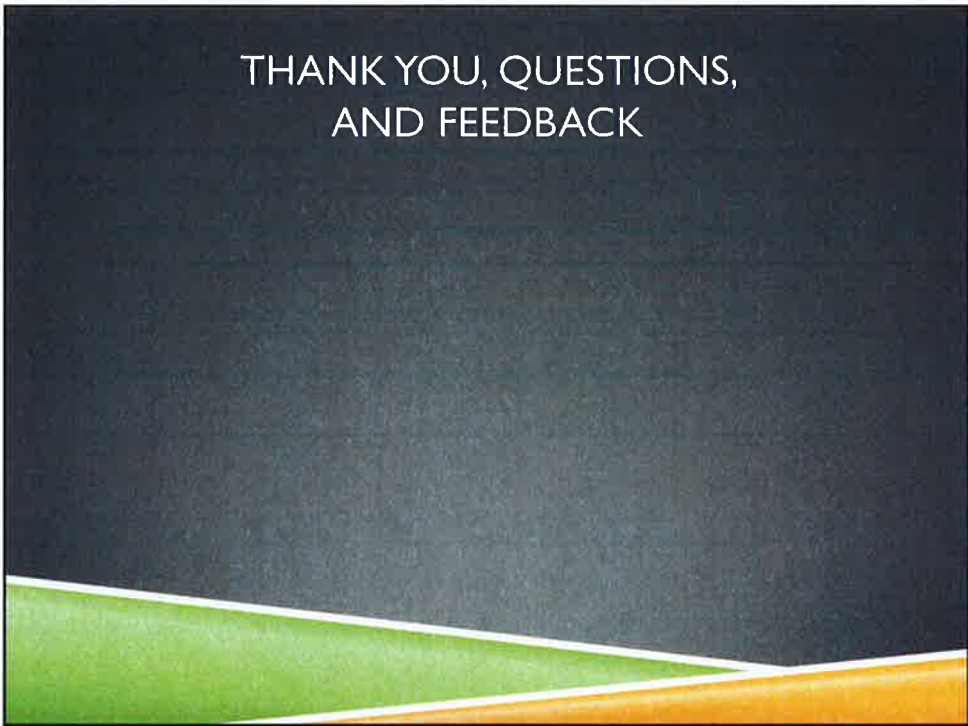
