

## Issue

A challenge or problem for debate or discussion

- **Enduring Issue**— a challenge or problem that a society has faced and debated or discussed across time. An enduring issue is one that many societies have attempted to address with varying degrees of success.

Enduring Issues are **HISTORICALLY SIGNIFICANT**. What is historical significance?

Something is **SIGNIFICANT** if it is **IMPORTANT**.

Something is **HISTORICALLY SIGNIFICANT** if it ....

- affected **a lot** of people
- had **long-lasting** effects
